2 full-range loudspeakers (1 subwoofer appreciated but not necessarily required) placed <u>behind</u> performing position (see page 1 "STAGE POSITIONS"). If the concert hall is small (below 150 seats) and of bright acoustic, then 2 active/ powered studio monitors (genelec, yamaha, adam etc) would be preferable! Can be without or - on special request - with 1 subwoofer.

wires/cables :

all wires/cables connecting from the small mixers output to the PA system. **1 power socket**

- 1 small table (or box, case, stool)


